belong to Estonia. The remainder of the commune will belong to Latvia.

7. Between the communes of *Omuli* and *Leel-Lugaschi* the frontier will follow the old administrative boundary; that is to say, the communes of *Pedel* and *Ehrgeme* will belong to Latvia.

8. The commune of Zore will belong to Estonia.

9. The decision as regards the communes of Leel Lugaschi, Walk and Kawershof has raised questions of exceptional difficulty. At one stage or another of the inquiry the Estonians have claimed the whole of these three communes. while the Letts have claimed the western half of Leel Lugaschi, the whole of Walk and the greater part of Kawershof. I have been confidently assured in evidence by the Estonian delegation that the town of Walk need not depend on Latvian sources of supply, and by the Latvian delegation that every resident of Lettish nationality, irrespective of his immediate economic interests, would desire, if possible, to be included in Latvia. Having regard to these statements, and taking into careful account the considerations laid down in the agreement of March 22nd. for the settlemant of the frontier. I have decided that the commune of Leel Lugaschi should be divided by a line running to the east of the Fellin road and that the communes of Walk and Kawershof should be divided by a line running up to the Werro road at a point outside Walk and thence the southern edge of that road. I think it well to point out that no practicable frontier in this part could have avoided much temporary economic disturbance. I recognise that, as in the town of Walk, the new frontier in these communes leaver a larger number of Lettish nationals in Estonia than of Estonian nationals in Latvia. So far as posible, I have taken this fact into account when dealing with districts containing a mixed population at other points of the frontier.

10. Between the communes of Kawershof and Neu Rosen the frontier will, for the most part by agreement between the two delegations, follow the old administrative frontier.
