TRAIT

TRAU can be reached from Spalato by little steamers which ply most days of the week, and, after rounding the headland of Monte Marjan, we enter the Gulf of Salona by a passage between Marjan and the island of Bua. Salona itself, with Klissa above it, lies away to the right, and the long wall of the Kozjac heights towers above the fertile Riviera dei Castelli. Less than an hour brings us to Traü. The preferable route is by carriage past Salona across the Jader, and then through the Seven Castles themselves. These Castelli, taken in their order on the road to Traü, are Sučurac, Gomilica, Lukšić, Stari, Novi and Stafilić. They were doubtless castles once, but almost all traces of the fortalices have now disappeared, and they are just picturesque little villages down by the water's edge, serving as
